Theory & Legal Aspects

The morning session focused on the fundamentals of gun safety and legal responsibilities.

- PLT Levie O. Sinatad discussed the Fundamental Rules of Gun Safety & Accident Prevention, highlighting: "Accidents are preventable—by following fundamental rules of gun safety, we safeguard both ourselves and others."

- PSSG Angelo Carlo Vallarta tackled Identification & Safe Distance Protocols, stressing: "Proper

identification and safe distance protocols are vital for journalists to remain secure in volatile situations."

- Col. Arnold S. Panaligan GSC PA, OIC Chief of Staff Commandant, RESCOM Training School concluded the session with a lecture on the Legal Aspects of Firearms in the Philippines, reminding participants: "Understanding the legal aspects of firearms empowers journalists to act responsibly and within the bounds of the law."

Afternoon Session:
Practical Familiarization
After lunch, participants underwent a

Range Safety Briefing before engaging in a supervised Fun Shoot Activity using standard 9mm pistols. The exercise, facilitated by AFP personnel, was designed purely for familiarization and not for competition. Each participant received one-on-one guidance, with all firearms, ammunition, and safety gear provided on-site.

The day concluded with an Open Forum and Recap, where participants

shared insights and clarified key points. The Closing Program featured the awarding of certificates, a group photo, and formal adjournment.

This initiative reflects PAPI's commitment to enhancing the safety and preparedness of journalists and media practitioners, ensuring they are equipped with both theoretical knowledge and practical skills when encountering firearms in the line of duty.
