KAUNA-UNAHANG ENOKI MUSHROOM FARM SA PILIPINAS, NASA CAVITE

SILANG, CAVITE — Isang bagong yugto sa agrikultura ng bansa ang nabuksan matapos maitayo sa Silang, Cavite ang kauna-unahang enoki mushroom farm sa Pilipinas—isang proyektong bunga ng pagtutulungan ng Department of Agriculture at ng kumpanyang Salad Time.



Ang enoki mushroom, na karaniwang inaangkat mula sa ibang bansa, ay maaari nang itanim, anihin, at iproseso mismo sa Pilipinas sa pamamagitan ng mga kabagong teknolohiyang binuo ng mga Pilipino.

Ayon sa mga namamahala sa proyekto, halos dalawang taon ang ginugol sa pag-aaral at pagbuo ng tamang proseso upang mapalago ang enoki mushroom sa klima ng bansa.

Kabilang dito ang pagde-develop ng sariling enoki spores sa laboratoryo, na dumaan

sa masusing pagsusuri bago tuluyang gamitin sa produksyon.

Matapos mabuo ang spores, inilalagay ang mga ito sa mga bote na may espesyal na pinaghalong organic materials gaya ng corn cob, soybean hull, oyster shell powder, at iba pang sangkap.

Dumaraan ang mga ito sa sterilization gamit ang autoclave upang matiyak na walang kontaminasyon bago ilagay sa incubation rooms, kung saan unti-unting tumutubo ang mga kabute hanggang maging handa para sa sprouting stage.

Kapag sapat na ang

paglaki, inaani ang mga enoki mushroom at agad na inilalagay sa cold storage upang mapanatili ang kalidad bago i-pack at ipadala sa mga pamilihan.

Sa kasalukuyan, ang bawat kahon ay naglalaman ng 50 packs ng enoki mushroom, at mabibili na ito sa ilang pangunahing supermarket gaya ng SM Supermarket, DALI, at O!Save, na may presyong nagsisimula sa humigit-kumulang P29.75 bawat pakete.

Nauna nang binanggit ni Pangulong Ferdinand Marcos Jr. sa kanyang State of the Nation Address (SONA) ang enoki

mushroom farming bilang isa sa mga bagong industriyang isinusulong ng pamahalaan upang palakasin ang lokal na agrikultura at lumikha ng mas maraming oportunidad para sa mga Pilipino.

Sa pagtatayo ng kauna-unahang enoki mushroom farm sa bansa, pinatutunayan na kayang makipagsabayan ng mga Pilipino sa makabagong agricultural technology at food production, lalo na kung nagtutulungan ang pamahalaan at pribadong sektor sa pagpapaunlad ng lokal na industriya. **(Sid Samaniego)**

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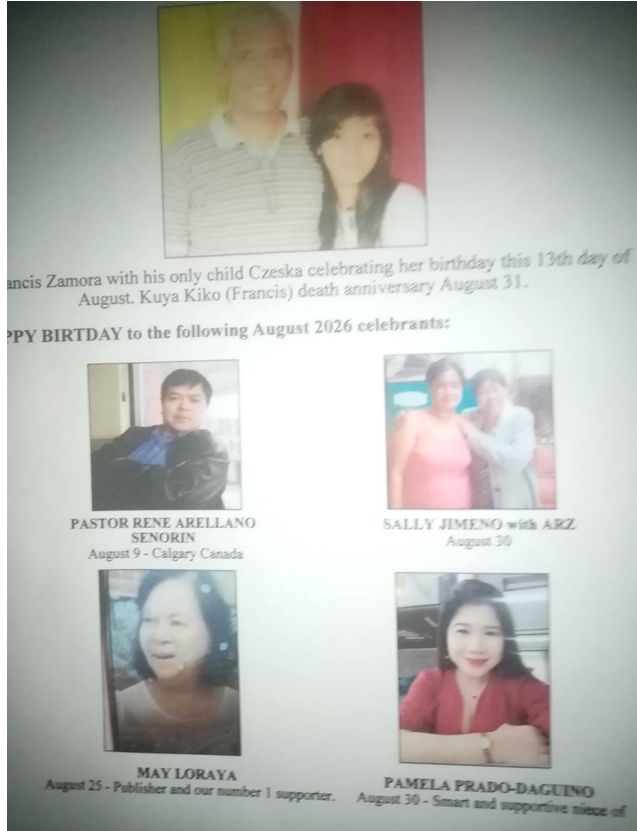
