On August 18, 2021, the Philippine Red Cross Cavite Chapter Health Services conducted a dry run of the Bakuna Bus in Cavite City where 63 persons, 60 of which were vaccinated with Sinovac and Janssen CoVID-19 vaccines.

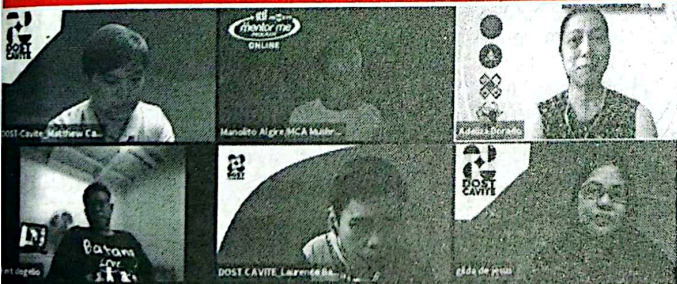
"To ascertain the genuineness of the NGC banknotes, the public is advised to use the Feel-Look-Tilt method to check the security features," ayon pa sa BSP.

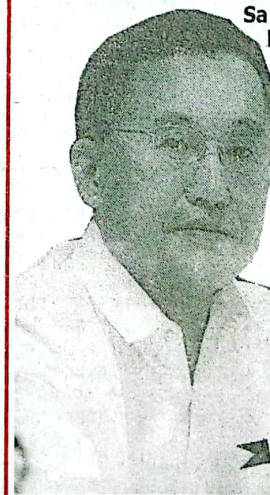
Vacuum-Freeze Drying Facility featured in DOST-Cavite TechOps

I sinailalim sa COVID-19 alert level 4 ang buong National Capital Region(NCR), maliban na lamang sa lungsod ng Maynila.

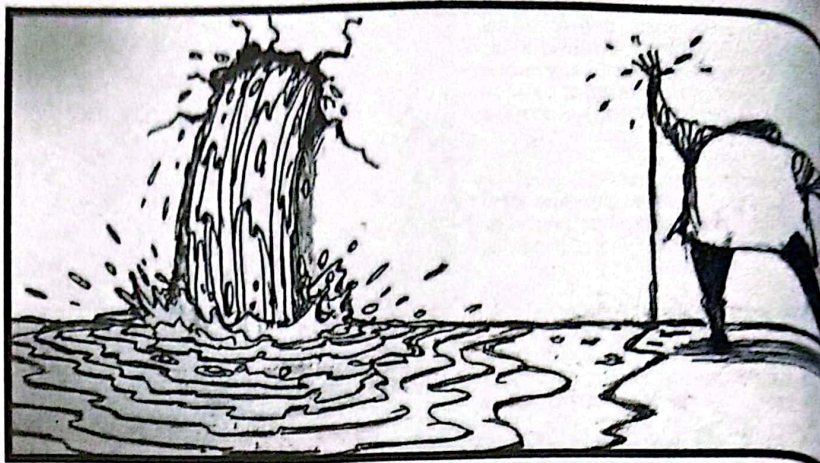
Ito ay bunsod ng patuloy na pagtaas ng mga naitalang bagong kaso ng sakit at hospitalisasyon sa rehiyon.

Ang impormasyon ay kinumpirma ni Health Undersecretary Maria Rosario Vergeire, dahil ayon sa datos ng kagawaran ang NCR ay nakapagtala ng positive 2 - week growth rate high risk average daily attack rate(ADAR) at high - risk case classification.

Base sa talaan ang Quezon City ay nakapagtala ng aktibong kaso na 7, 800 kasunod ang Maynila 5, 005; Caloocan City 3, 826; Pasig City 3, 561 at Makati City 3, 529.

Ayon pa sa klasipikasyon ng DOH ang alert level 4 ay itinataas sa isang lugar kung umakyat na sa 70% pataas ang hospital bed capacity at nasa ilalim naman ng moderate hanggang critical risk.

Samantlang ang alert level 3 ay nasa moderate hanggang critical risk at hindi pa umaabot sa mahigit 70% ang ICU utilization rate.

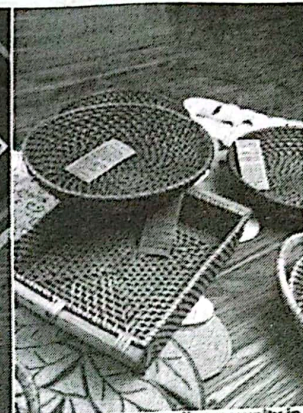

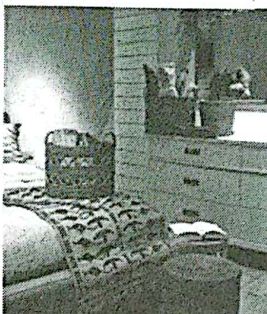

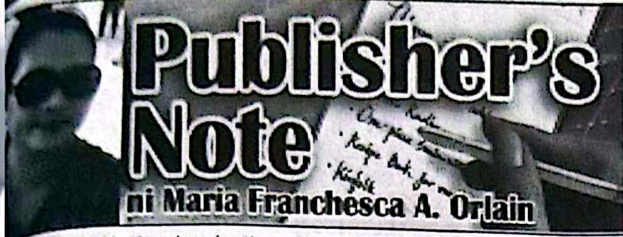

Dr. Adeliza A. Dorado, Associate Professor in the University of the Philippines Los Baños, presented vacuum freeze-dryer operation during the three-hour activity. She identified long duration of processing time and high operating cost as "weights" or disadvantages of the technology. On the other hand, preservation, longevity of shelf life, and hygroscopicity (or water-

absorptivity which allows for easy reconstitution) were discussed as "pulls" or advantages of the technology.

During the open forum, Dr. Dorado addressed some concerns of the participants on the use of the vacuum freeze-dryer. For one, she emphasized that the technology preserves the nutrient content of fruits or vegetables that undertook the vacuum

freeze-drying process as compared to other drying methods, such as air- or sun-drying. The original intended use of vacuum freeze-drying is to preserve pharmaceutical products (the process known as lyophilization) which exemplified the content retention of raw materials undergoing the said drying process.

The Municipal Agriculture Office of General Emilio Aguinaldo "Bailen", Cavite and the Cavite Office of the Provincial Agriculturist expressed interest in adopting the technology for their assisted farmers' association, to which Mr. Matthew Henry G. Camitan of the DOST-Cavite responded that the provision of the technology is possible through the DOST

Grants-in-Aid (GIA) Program. Under this program, the DOST-CALABARZON acquired a vacuum freeze-drying equipment, currently housed in the CALABARZON Food Solutions Hub (CFoSH) in Laguna, for use of the Association of Laguna Food Processors and other food enterprises in the region in developing and commercializing novel food products.

As of September 5, 2021, the Regional Biosurveillance Update reported a total of 298 Delta variant cases identified from among the five provinces namely Laguna with 85 cases, Cavite with 71 cases, Rizal - 62, Batangas - 43, and Quezon - 26. Lucena City has 11 recorded cases.

Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo disclosed that there were two cases admitted for treatment in the province of Quezon. "A total of 172 patients have recovered and 116 individuals are for verification."

There were 8 Delta variant deaths recorded, two each from the provinces of Rizal and Quezon, one each in the provinces Cavite, Laguna and Batangas and one from Lucena City.

Janairo advised residents to follow religiously the standard safety protocols and avoid crowded public

areas. "Better stay at home and be safe."

"Magpalista na sa inyong mga lokal na pamahalaan upang makatanggap ng bakuna laban sa Covid virus. Napakaimportante ngayon na magkaroon ng proteksyon lalo pa at dumarami ang kaso natin sa rehiyon," he emphasized.

There are now a total of 4,934,493 individuals in the region who were vaccinated from the total allocation of 6,439,936.

And as of September 6, 2021, a total of 275,747 Covid-19 cases were recorded with 39,104 active cases while 228,645 have already recovered from the virus. There were 7,998 deaths.

Janairo said that mass antigen testing will continue to further identify and detect Covid cases in the region to prevent their spread in the communities.

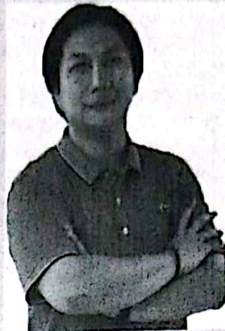

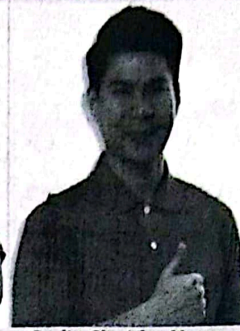

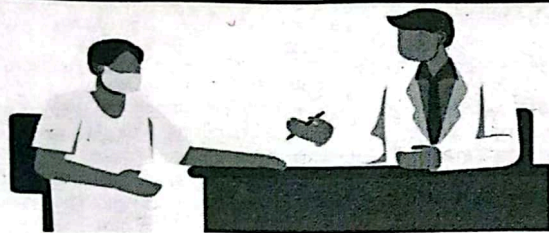
DOH-CALABARZON PROJECT DELTA CONDUCTS COVID MASS TESTING IN QUEZON
